Tips and Tricks

It's time to think about switching to a low-temperature food if you haven't already. When the water temperature reaches 55 degrees, stop feeding your fish altogether. Their ability to digest food is directly related to water temperature and if they are not able to digest the food properly, they may die.

An important step in wintering over your fish is to keep an opening in the ice. Decaying organic matter in the pond will release toxic gases which will build up under the ice if there is not a way for it to escape. De-icers are available to help keep the surface open.

Remember, the work you do this Fall will pay dividends when you get ready to open your pond for the season in the Spring.
